Article 1. Chapter Introduction

Article 2. Chapter Purposes

This chapter of the Mental Health Warrior League is a subdivision of Inspiring My Generation Corporation, organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

This Mental Health Warrior League will promote Inspiring My Generation's mission to prevent suicide among the youth through education on mental health awareness, early symptom detection, and emotional support.

This Mental Health Warrior League will:

- **Educate.** A vital piece of suicide prevention is education on mental health, mental wellness, and mental health conditions. Mental Health Warrior Leagues are committed to teach your peers and community about the importance of early symptom detection and building an emotional support system.
- **Advocate.** Advocating for mental health awareness comes in many forms. Mental Health Warrior Leagues are dedicated to promoting awareness through ensuring counseling services are available on campuses and engaging peers in the numerous initiatives run by Inspiring My Generation (including the Normalize the Conversation, Encouragement Card Program, and You Are Not Alone initiatives).
- **Fundraise.** Raise money to help expand the reach of Inspiring My Generation’s initiatives and overall mission to bridge the gap in mental health awareness, emotional support, and treatment accessibility with a direct focus on suicide prevention through early symptom detection and support for individuals living with mental illness.

Article 3. Leadership Team Positions

Additional Leadership Positions:

It shall be the duty of the leadership team to:

- Perform any and all duties imposed on them collectively or individually.
- Appoint members of the leadership team through a fair election with proper qualifications.
- Remove members of the leadership team who do not fulfill their duties or represent the values of Inspiring My Generation.
- Supervise all chapter sanctioned meetings, events, and fundraisers.
- Meet on the days and times established within these bylaws.
- Register this chapter of the Mental Health Warrior League with Inspiring My Generation.

The term of a leadership position will be _____ and until his/her/their successor is elected and qualifies.

Article 4. Meetings

Unless otherwise approved, the following provisions shall govern the giving notice for meetings of members and the leadership team:

- **Regular Meetings.** No notice needs to be given, as these meetings are pre-scheduled according to Article 1 of these bylaws.
- **Special Meetings.** At least one week notice needs to be given by the Secretary of this chapter of the Mental Health Warrior League to each member. Such notice may be oral or written, may be given personally, by telephone, or email, and shall state the place, date, and time of the meeting and matters proposed to be acted upon at the meeting.

Article 5. Leadership Team Responsibilities

The official responsibilities of the Leadership Team Members include:

- **President.** The President shall supervise and control the affairs of the Mental Health Warrior League. The President shall preside over all meetings and execute responsibilities according to the values and mission of Inspiring My Generation. In the event the Secretary is unable to attend a meeting, the President will be responsible for appointing a secretary of the meeting.
- **Vice President.** The Vice President shall perform the duties of the President in the event the President is unable to act. The Vice President will also execute tasks and manage committees as described by the President.
- **Secretary.** The Secretary shall certify and keep a copy of these bylaws as amended to date, give notice of all meetings, events, and fundraisers hosted by the Mental Health Warrior League, ensure all meeting minutes are taken, a book of all meeting minutes and meeting notices, and keep a record of all members with contact information.
- **Treasurer.** The Treasurer shall be responsible for all funds raised through the chapter of the Mental Health Warrior League and be responsible for delivering raised funds to Inspiring My Generation. The Treasurer must also keep and maintain adequate and correct amounts of money raised versus expenses and maintain an updated book of financial records, which may be requested by the Leadership Team and Inspiring My Generation at will.

Article 6. Committees

This chapter of the Mental Health Warrior League may create committees to carry out the initiatives and mission of the League in alignment with Inspiring My Generation.

Meetings held by each committee shall be governed in accordance with the member meetings. All meeting minutes must be recorded and shared with the Secretary.

Example Committees include:

- Education Committee
- Advocacy Committee
- Fundraising Committee.

Official Committees created by this chapter of Mental Health Warrior League:

Article 7. Membership

Membership is open to young adults, ranging from middle school to graduate school, who are interested in creating a mental health stigma free world. The League and its members will not discriminate against any individual for reasons of race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, national origin, gender, physical and mental handicap, or veteran status.

Membership dues may be collected for the purposes of fundraising for Inspiring My Generation or to purchase Inspiring My Generation t-shirts for League sanctioned events.
